The Italian Group on Pesticides and Environment (GRIFA), the MGPR (Mediterranean Group of Pesticide Research), and the Department of Life and Environmental Science organize the summer school for young researchers involved in Pesticide Sciences with particular interest in Environmental fate, Food safety and Sustainable practices. The event will take place at the University of Cagliari (Cagliari, Sardinia, Italy) between August 02 and 04, 2012.

The aims of the summer school are:

* to provide training on learning and teaching related topics

* to provide networking opportunities to a multinational group of newly appointed lecturers from universities, private and public institutions across Europe.

Training sessions will be delivered by experts on research education.

The school will be organized in one session per day. Each session will be structured with two plenary lectures given by expert scientists, and one lecture given by the attendance. All attendees are invited to submit an expression of interest to participate in communication action with an abstract of 2000 characters, reporting the main topics of the communication proposed among the topics suggested by the Organizing Committee.

The scientific committee will select the communications from young researchers. The remaining presentations will be

presented as open poster during a specific session.

This year the main topic of the School will be focused on botanical pesticides pest management and regulations.

The following topics will be discussed :

1) *Secondary metabolites* (Prof. Sabino A. Bufo - Università degli Studi della Basilicata, Potenza, President of GRIFA)

2) *Italian and European Legislation* (Dr. Fabrizio Jondini - Expedia MRCC).

3) *Plant-derived Nematocides* (Dr. Nicoletta Ntalli - Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, Greece).

4) *Behaviour of pesticide in soil* (Dr. Teodoro Miano - Di.B.C.A.Bari).

5) *Glucosinolati- mirosinasi a natural pest control system in brassicaceae* (Dr. Ilaria Braschi – DiSTA, Bologna).

6) *Biopesticides-Production and optimization through chemical and biotechnological processes.* (Prof. Azucena González-Coloma - IPNA-CSIC, Spain)

A final programme will be sent to all registered attendees.
